Bib Pick Up and Registration

All participants must pick up their bibs at the Expo prior to race day. Bibs will not be available for pickup on race morning, so please plan accordingly.

IMPORTANT:

There are no pre-assigned bib numbers — simply head to the packet pick-up area for your race distance.

We do not mail out bibs; you must attend the expo or have someone pick up for you.

What you need to bring:

Have your Race Roster confirmation (with QR code) ready on your phone or printed. Can't find it? Log into your Race Roster dashboard and click your "Confirmation number" link. See below.


Picking up for someone else is permitted. Please bring a copy of their confirmation too (digital copy or print out is fine).


Registration Questions:
